BURNING ORDINANCE

The Township of Chassell, Houghton County establishes the following:

Section 1: This ordinance adopted in the interest of public safety is intended to promote the general peace, health, safety and welfare of the people of Chassell Township by preventing foul odors and pollution of air.

Section 2: No person living in the Township of Chassell in the following zoning districts, Urban Residential, Industrial, Office, Business(excluding Portage Entry) and US 41 Multi-Use District North and the South US 41 Multi-Use District, traveling south from Chassell on US 41 to the Sturgeon River shall burn any garbage, refuse, trash, yard waste, rubbish, plastic or animal carcasses, or parts thereof, in the outdoors whether or not such materials are in a burn barrel, fire pit or other burning container.

Section 3: Persons living in the Rural zoning district, South US 41 Multi-Use District from Snake River south to South Klingville Rd and the business district of Portage Entry shall be allowed to only dispose of non-chlorinated paper and yard waste by burning in a burning container approved by the Department of Natural Resources.

Section 4: Clean, untreated, dry wood burned in fireplaces, fire pits and woodstoves whether in a dwelling or in the outdoors is allowed in all zoning districts.

Section 5: Any person, partnership, firm, association or corporation who shall violate this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall upon conviction therefore, be subject to a fine or penalty of not less that \$50, or more than \$100.

Section 4: This ordinance shall become effective the first day of October 2005.
