- e. Blight ordinance. Brian and Keith will finalize the survey, but the commission discussed potential items to include in the survey, including:
 - 1. Township-wide or corridor approach
 - 2. How to help people with financial problems
 - 3. Should such an ordinance address the facade or entire house
