- 7. Guest Speaker John Pekkala
 - a. Intro by Keith-John Pekkala, Houghton County Drain Commission. Brought him on to discuss the master plan and ensuring we address flood issues in the township. After the flood-The County Emergency Coordinator signed a letter addressing township officials about drainage issues in the County. Unless our municipality has created a drain commission, local municipalities are responsible for drainage issues.
 - Establishing a County Drain is a big project. Current areas of jurisdiction: MDOT has highway jurisdiction, County has road jurisdiction, and private property
 - c. John provided the commission with a handout for establishing a Drain District. Township board can pass a resolution to establish a drain district, give to drain commission, then the County, then County must pass a resolution either cover the bill or requiring a cash deposit to layout the drain district. This may be a good option for the Township to help raise money to fund drainage problems. This will be a large project. The Township would need to determine if we should do it as a millage township wide, or property specific through certain drainage districts.
